Level of experience required: Beginning

Fiber Art – The Fine Art of Weaving

Level of experience required: Beginning and Intermediate

Class description: Be part of the global renaissance in fiber art! Learn the timeless art, design and craft of weaving on a hand loom. Slow down, be in the moment and synchronize your body, mind and spirit as you create a lovely work of art! It's like a meditation and you get to keep what you envision! Looms, yarn, and shuttles provided.

In this six-week course you will get to know the parts and workings of a rigid heddle loom, learn universal weaving terminology and techniques, develop your own rhythm. Projects: A table mat/runner and two mug rugs; a small tapestry, starting and finishing techniques, dressing the loom.
